- Former Under Secretary General and The Special Representative on Children and Armed Conflict.
- Lead author of the Global Study on the Implementation of Resolution 1325 published in 2015 and was the Special Rapporteur on Violence Against Women from 1994-2003.
- In Sri Lanka, she was the Chairperson of the National Human Rights Commission from 2003-2006 - a fierce advocate for ordinary citizens who were victims of torture and disappearances.
- Published extensively on human rights, constitutional law, social theory, international law and law and society.
- Delivered the Grotius lecture at the American Society of International Law, the Eli Lauterpacht lectures at Cambridge in 2020 on the topic of 'Women and Children and the Transformation of International Law'.
- Delivered the Tanner lectures on 'Human Values' (Tanner lecturers have included the most distinguished scholars in the world, whether they be scientists, philosophers, historians or economists, as well as jurists).
